Dear Parents and Carers

I would like to thank you for your patience and understanding over the few months whilst I have been back in the classroom. I have thoroughly enjoyed returning to the classroom, although the workload and pressure is definitely not sustainable.

She has settled into Year 1 exceptionally well (covering Mrs Ijagbone, following the birth of her daughter) and is already incredibly fond of her class. She has brought a wealth of experience with her, across Key Stage 1 and 2, and is also an experienced subject lead.

Miss Hewitt has joined us this week in Early Years (replacing Mrs Hale, who is very much enjoying her retirement!) and our youngest pupils have already made her feel very welcome indeed!
