Initially we will complete, review and assess our last topic before moving on to our new topic, which will be Sound. We will identify how sounds are made, associating some of them with something vibrating. We will recognise that vibrations from sounds travel through a medium to the ear. We will explore pitch, volume and that sounds get fainter as the distance from the sound source increases.
