



Maintenance Fund

As the end of the academic year draws nearer some parents have yet to pay their maintenance fund.

As a Church of England school we are required to pay:

The Southwark Diocesan Board of Education a yearly maintenance fund. This contributes to the maintenance of the land and buildings. This also enables school funding to be used on other important learning resources for the children. The amount we require you to pay is:

Children in Reception and older £24

Nursery children £12

(Please note that we have been asked to increase this amount next year.)

In recent years this fund has been used to help pay towards the following projects:-

- New playground surface and equipment
- Heating - new boiler installed
- A class set of Chrome books (laptops) which are used by all children
- Updated computer equipment

It is very important that parents pay this fund so the school can continue to provide the safe and enriched learning environment that our children deserve.

As an added incentive, all children whose families pay the maintenance fund will receive a special BJR branded pencil to use either in school or at home.

Governors and staff will be collecting this payment from the school gates on XXX. Parents will also be able to check if they have paid and receive their pencils.
