Uniform for autumn and spring Term

- Grey trousers, shorts, skirt or tunic
- Plain white long sleeved or short sleeved blouse or shirt
- Grey or black socks or tights
- School cardigan or sweatshirt (which must have the school logo)
- Sturdy black shoes fastened with elastic, laces, buckles or Velcro which the child is able to take on and off independently. Sandals, open footwear or shoes that do not protect the foot or can easily slip off are not allowed.
- School tie (elasticated ties in EYFS and KS1, real ties for KS2)
- Branded book bag

Optional Summer Term uniform

- Red/White checked dress
- White polo t-shirt (ties are optional in the summer)
- BJR branded cap

PE KIT:

Normal School uniform is not permissible for PE/Games. Each child must be equipped as outlined below every School day. Kit must be kept in a clearly named (on the outside) PE Bag, brought to School each Monday and taken home for washing each Friday.
