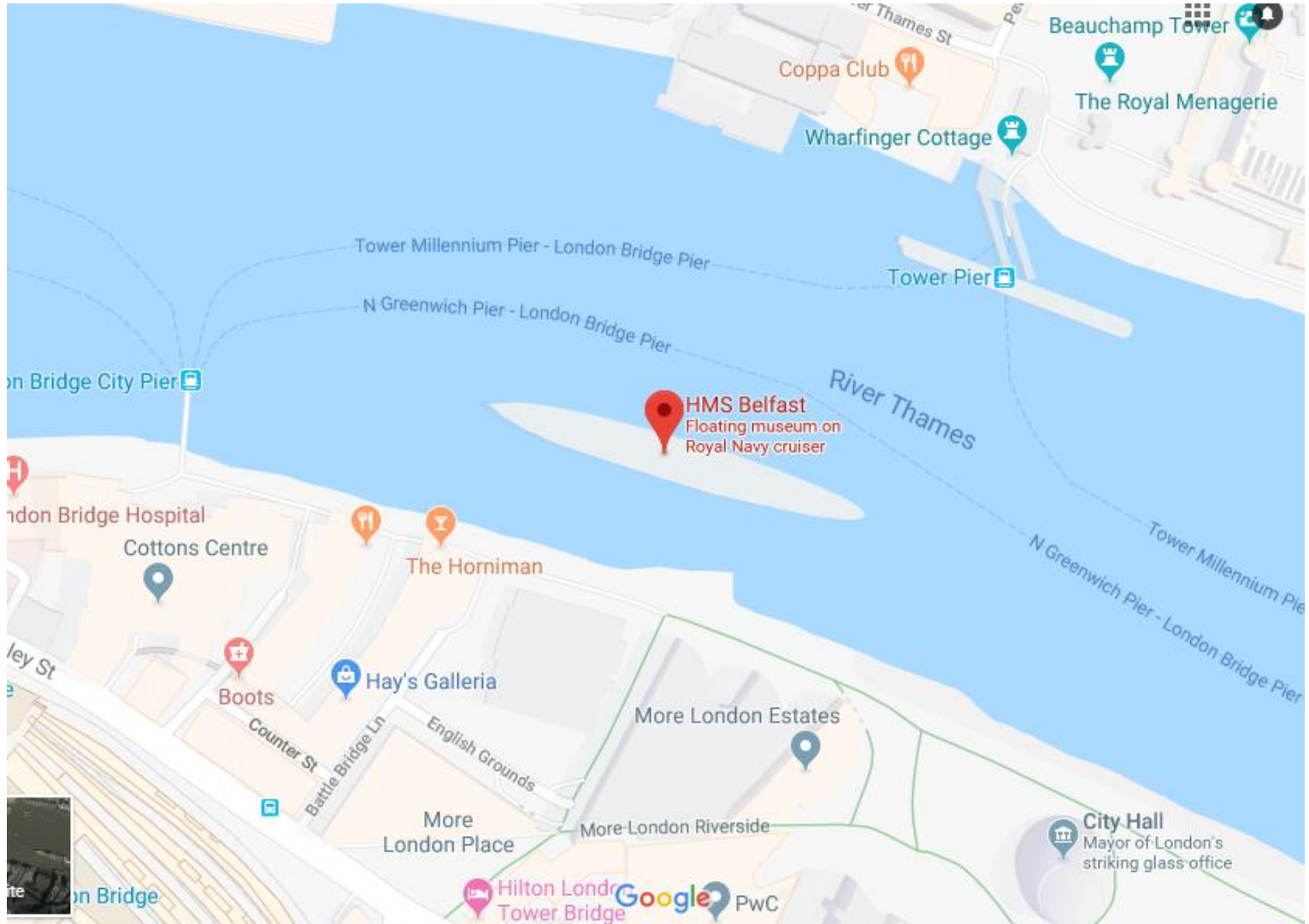
- A night's accommodation on HMS Belfast
