Dear Parents and Carers,

As we move to the next phase of the Government's roadmap for releasing us from the Covid restrictions, I would like to update you on our Covid safe practices at school. For the remainder of the academic school year:

- we will continue to operate our staggered start and finish times,
- we will continue to use our one-way system for drop off and collection each day,
- all visitors (including parents and carers) will be required to wear a mask on site, unless exempt,
- all meetings (wherever possible) with visitors, parents and carers will be via Zoom.

We have been fortunate in being able to minimise the risks to staff, children and parents and wish to ensure our whole community stays safe. I am really proud of the online and home-learning provision our teachers created during the spring lockdown, but I have no desire to go into another lockdown and so want to ensure we do everything we can to limit any risks.

We are now allowing some school visits to take place, in line with Government restrictions and with regard to all risk assessments. We are also looking at how we can run sports day and end of year celebrations in a Covid safe way for our pupils and staff, ensuring social distancing and keeping our bubbles secure. We will keep you informed of any updates.

We have over the past 18 months introduced a number of practices that we are keen to hear your feedback on, as moving forward, we may continue with some of these changes. For example, many parents have had a positive experience of the virtual parents' evening consultations.
