For this, we will be looking at our letter writing skills, recapping the key features of a letter.- In Maths, we are looking at Money. We will be recapping how many pennies in £1, and looking at different ways to make different amounts. We will also be recapping on our knowledge, and working on our exam technique. This includes answering word problems.- In P.E, we are playing team games, learning to cheer each other on whilst working on our coordination and team spirit!

This is linked to our current text, 'Dear Greenpeace'.- In Maths, we are going to be looking at time, specifically using the minute hand. We will also be continuing our work on exam technique.- In guided reading we will continue looking at how to answer questions reading into a text, such as telling how a character feels by how the author describes them.
