In School
 Assessment Week In Maths we will be making equal parts in fraction, recognising and finding a half as well as a quarter.
• In English this week, we will use the text 'Mouse Bird Snake Wolf' to write in role using freeze frames. We will also write a description using the same language as the book.
 In Science this half term, we will look at the five food groups and how food provides energy and nutrition to animals including humans.
• In Maths we will recognise and calculate unit fractions as well as non-unit fractions. In addition, we will look at the equivalence of 1/2and 2/4.
• In English we will be reading the text 'The Great Kapok Tree' and writing a diary entry.
• In Geography, we will name countries which contain tropical rainforests and find out some facts about them.
 In Maths we will be learning about length and perimeter by measuring length, finding equivalent length and comparing length. We will also be calculating perimeter.
 In English we will be writing a newspaper report using Adverbs and Adverbial phrases.
• In Art, we will research and experiment based on the rainforest painting by Henri Rousseau
